"Best Picture" Jacket-Design Contest winners will be notified via telephone and/or e-mail by noon on Friday, February 5, 2010, and may pick up a denim jacket for decorating at that time.

Contest winners must deliver decorated denim jackets no later than 5 pm on Friday, February 26, 2010, to the Community Theatre of Greensboro office on the third floor of the Greensboro Cultural Center, 200 North Davie Street, Greensboro, NC 27401.

Official Contest Participant Agreement
